## Call for Applicants Grants for Graduate Students Researching Antisemitism or Racism

Tel Aviv University's Stephen Roth Institute for the Study of Antisemitism and Racism invites MA and PhD students at TAU to apply for a research grant that supports scholarship contributing to the study and understanding of either antisemitism or racism, including racism in Israel. Candidates are welcome from a range of different academic fields including the Humanities, Social Sciences, Jewish Studies, Law, Arts, Medicine, Business and more.

## **Requirements of grant recipients:**

- To note the Roth Institute's support in any academic work (published or nonpublished) completed with the support of the research grant, and to share a copy of all completed academic works with the Roth Institute.
- 2. To participate in occasional seminars, workshops and other academic programs organized by the Roth Institute over the course of the year.

## Applicants should submit the following materials:

- 1. A copy of their research proposal, approved or pending approval.
- 2. Two letters of recommendation from scholars in their field, including a letter from their advisor (to be sent directly to the Roth Institute at: roth@post.tau.ac.il).
- 3. A concise CV, including contact information.
- 4. A brief letter detailing the applicant's current research and its contribution to the study of either antisemitism or racism.
